

HOLY WEEK RESURRECTION EGGS

Hide the 10 Plastic Eggs with their respective Message & Object. Once the Children have found all the Eggs, Open them in their respective order. Read the Scripture & do the Activities associated to these scriptures Each Day leading up to Easter Sunday. There are sometimes more than one scripture per Egg but there is a * next to the verse we use in our Eggs & I have put the Message to write below.

DO EGGS 1 & 2 TOGETHER

EGG 1 - PALM SUNDAY

***Matthew 21:7-9 ; Mark 11: 7-10 ; John 12:12-13; Luke 19:35-38**



- EGG: Put the Above Scripture & a Leaf to represent a palm leaf into the Egg
- LESSON: Jesus went to Jerusalem to celebrate the Passover. He rode into Jerusalem on a young donkey. A large crowd spread their coats & lay palm leaves on the road to welcome Him as they Shouted "Hosanna to the Son of David" Matthew 21:7-9
- ACTIVITY: See Activity List

EGG 2- THE COINS

***Matthew 26:14-15; Mark 14: 10-11; Luke 22:3-5**



- EGG: Put the Verse and a coin to represent the coins Judas betrayed Jesus for
- LESSON: Judas Iscariot, one of the 12 Disciples of Jesus went to the chief priests to betray Jesus to them. They gave him 30 pieces of silver Matthew 26:14-15

DO EGGS 3 & 4 TOGETHER

EGG 3 - WASHING OF FEET

***John 13:4-5**



- EGG: Put the Verse & a piece of cloth to represent washing of feet in the Egg
- LESSON: During the Passover meal, Jesus got up, took off His outer clothes and wrapped a towel around his waist. After that, he poured water into a large bowl and began to wash his disciples feet John 13:4-5
- ACTIVITY: See Activity List

EGG 4 - LAST SUPPER

***Matthew 26:26-28 ; Luke 22:19-20 ; Mark 14: 22-24**



- EGG: Put the Verse & a piece of bread, cracker or communion cup to represent the last supper in the Egg
- LESSON: While they were eating, Jesus took a piece of bread, gave a prayer of thanks, broke it and gave it to His disciples. "Take and Eat it" He said, "This is my body, Do it in remembrance of Me" Matthew 26:26

DO EGGS 8 & 9 TOGETHER

EGG 8 - BURIAL OF JESUS



***Luke 23:50-53; John 19:38-42; Mark 15:42-46 Matthew 27:57-60**

EGG: Put the Verse & a piece of Cloth into the Egg
LESSON: A man named Joseph approached Pilate to ask for the body of Jesus. Joseph wrapped the body in spices and strips of linen, then placed it in a new tomb cut out of the rock Luke 23:50-53

EGG 9 - THE BURIAL STONE



***Matthew 27:59-66**

EGG: Put the Verse & a small stone inside the Egg
LESSON: Joseph took the body, wrapped it in a new linen sheet, and placed it in his own new tomb, which he had just recently dug out of solid rock. Then he rolled a large stone across the entrance to the tomb - Matthew 27:59-60

DO EGG 10 ALONE

EGG 10 - HE HAS RISEN

***Mark 16:1-6; John 20:1-2; Luke 24:1-6; *Matthew 28:6**



EGG: Put the Verse & a small cross or Easter Egg inside the Egg

LESSON: He is not here, He has Risen, just as He said He would Matthew 28:6

ACTIVITIES



EGG 1 & 2 ACTIVITY



There are a few activities you choose from:

- Colour in the Palm Tree Designs attached in "Extra"
- Colour in the Donkey Designs attached in "Extra"
- Have your children collect leaves and cut them to represent a palm tree
- Trace your children's hands and have them colour in these designs and then staple them together to make palm trees
- You can also have your children count out 30 silver coins to show what Judas pretreated Jesus for



EGG 3 & 4 ACTIVITY



There are a few activities you choose from:

- Have communion together as a family
- Have a Thanksgiving Supper together as a family breaking bread and remembering the last supper Jesus had with his Disciples
- Go around the Table as family and all mention something you are Thankful to Jesus for
- Get a bucket, soap and a towel and wash each other's feet! Pedicure time! Teach your kids about having a servant heart like Jesus and putting others first

EGG 5 & 6 ACTIVITY



There are a few activities you choose from:

- Go into the Garden with your children and pray with them
- Pick flowers and do a flower arrangement
- Give Someone a flower and tell them that "Joy Comes in The Morning!"
- Make a crown of leaves or a crown out of paper and tell your children about the crown of thorns on Jesus's head and how He is Our King





ACTIVITIES



EGG 7 ACTIVITY

There are a few activities you choose from:

- Get Big Roll Out Paper and make a cross out of it on the floor and Stick it down with sticky tape. Then give each child a section of the cross to write their names, draw pictures and think of how Jesus thought of them on the cross. They can also write all what they want to say sorry for on the cross. Teach the concept of forgiveness.
- If you dont have paper, You can also do the above by drawing a big cross out of chalk on a surface like a driveway. Then give each child a piece of chalk and they can do the same activity as above
- You can also get a piece of wood and nail your children's names in the wood to signify the same lesson above
- You can also put a red mark on your children's hands, or draw a hand and draw a red dot on it, to signify the nailing to the cross. My children are rather sensitive to this... so I dont do this one with them



EGG 8 & 9 ACTIVITY



There are a few activities you choose from:

- Find stones in the gardens and then paint them!
- You can also paint boiled eggs.
- Paint Images of Joy and Hope like a Cross, Flowers, Light, Sun, a Rainbow, Butterfly etc....
- You could also paint a large canvas with the children or they could each do a painting of anything Easter, Hope, Love or Resurrection related
- You could also do Paper Mache with the Children to represent how Jesus's body was covered with cloth



EGG 10 ACTIVITY



There are a few Activities you can choose from:

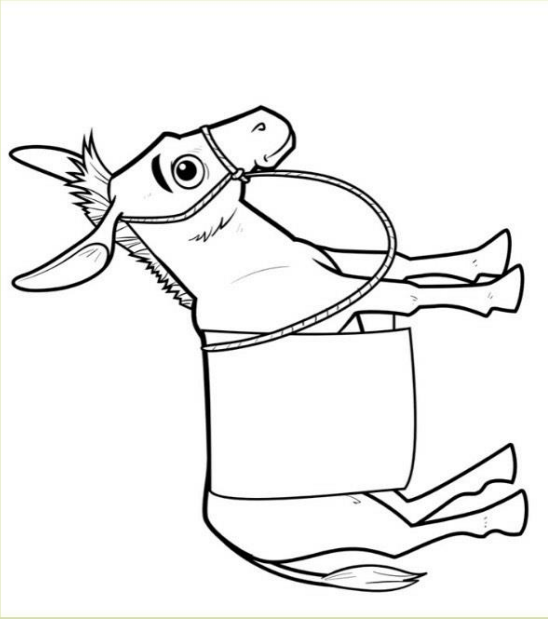
- "He is Risen!" Spread Joy!
- Easter Egg Hunts! Although Eggs are not mentioned in the Bible, Christians have used Easter Eggs to Celebrate Easter for Ages! We use Eggs to represent New Life (in Jesus) and The Empty Tomb. It also brings such Joy & Excitment for our Kids- Spread Joy!
- Make Resurrection Buns with your kids! Get Crescent Rolls and cut it into a triangle. Get a marshmallow and dip it in oil, sugar and cinnamon to represent anointing Jesus's body and then wrap the marshmallow in the crescent roll. This represents wrapping Jesus body in the linen and then putting him behind the heavy stone in the cave. Then Bake these in the oven for 5-10 Minutes. When you take the buns out, the marshemellow is gone! Just like the Tomb was empty.

LESSONS FOR RESURRECTION EGGS

LESSON EGG 1: Jesus went to Jerusalem to celebrate the Passover. He rode into Jerusalem on a young donkey. A large crowd spread their coats & lay palm leaves on the road to welcome Him as they Shouted "Hosanna to the Son of David" Matthew 21:7-9

LESSON EGG 5: After the Passover Meal, Jesus went with His disciples to the Garden of Gethsemane to pray Matthew 26: 36

LESSON EGG 6: Then they made a crown out of thorny branches and placed it on His head, and put a stick in His right hand, then they knelt before Him and made fun of Him. "Long Live the King of the Jews" they said Matthew 27: 27-31

LESSON EGG 7: He went Out Carrying His cross, and came to "The Place of the Skull" as it is called. (in Hebrew it is called Golgotha) There they nailed Him to the cross - John 19:17-18

LESSON EGG 8: A man named Joseph approached Pilate to ask for the body of Jesus. Joseph wrapped the body in spices and strips of linen, then placed it in a new tomb cut out of the rock Luke 23:50-53
